

Details: On the morning of 11/05/13, I presented an *Affidavit for Search Warrant* to Lane County Circuit Court Judge Ilisa Rooke-Ley in application for a warrant to search the home of Andrew Clark for evidence relating to the charged crimes. Judge Rooke-Ley agreed that probable cause did in fact exist and issued a warrant directing me to search the home of Clark.

See involved *Affidavit for Search Warrant* as well as the actual *Search Warrant*.

Also on the morning of 11/05/13, Andrew Clark appeared with his attorney Kevin Bons before Lane County Circuit Court Judge Jay McAlpin. Present at the hearing as well was Deputy District Attorney Erik Hasselman. DDA Hasselman was aware I was applying for a search warrant prior to the hearing before Judge McAlpin. Before the conclusion of the hearing, I communicated to DDA Hasselman that I was granted a warrant to search the home of Andrew Clark.

Andrew Clark was subsequently taken into custody at the conclusion of the hearing due to a violation of his jail release agreement. Clark asked if he could be permitted to make a phone call before being physically taken into custody by the attending sheriff deputies. Clark was allowed to make a phone call and utilized his attorney's cell phone after we all stepped out to the lobby of the courthouse. DDA Hasselman spoke with attorney Kevin Bons and told him we had one other matter to speak with him and Andrew Clark about upon conclusion of the phone call.

After Andrew Clark and attorney Kevin Bonds joined us at a nearby bench, DDA Hasselman told them that I had been granted a warrant to search the home of Andrew Clark. I then read a true copy of the warrant (signed in ink by Judge Rooke-Ley) to Andrew Clark while his attorney was present. I then handed Andrew Clark the true copy of the warrant. (9:05 a.m.) Andrew Clark was agreeable to provide us with the security code to his front door in order to facilitate the search. Andrew Clark also said that we would find his computer system in close proximity to the front door. Andrew Clark confirmed that his female friend would likely not be at the house when we served the warrant.

Andrew Clark was then taken into physical custody by the attending sheriff deputies and presumably transported to the jail. Prior to parting ways with attorney Kevin Bons, he told me that we would find legally privileged communication between him and Andrew

Clark on Clark's computer. I then told DDA Hasselman of this, and he instructed me to disregard and not read (or seize) any printed documents that appeared to be between attorney Kevin Bons and Andrew Clark. DDA Hasselman would later follow-up by sending an e-mail to attorney Kevin Bons, advising him of the instructions to myself and forensic computer analyst Detective Steve Williams about disregarding any privileged communication we might come across in the execution of the search warrant and during later computer analysis. *See attached copy of e-mail.*

After leaving the courthouse, I drove to the home of Andrew Clark where detectives Thompson, Roth, and Williams were waiting for me. After knocking on the door and ringing the door bell to ensure that no one was at home, I utilized the code provided by Andrew Clark and was able to unlock the front door of the house. (9:40 a.m.) My three co-workers then cleared all rooms in the home to assure that no one else was present. While they did this, I began to take pre-search photographs of the interior of the house to document its condition as well as that of any evidence.


The interior of the home was sparsely furnished, dirty, and largely in disarray with the exception of rooms at the front of the house. A significant odor of mold was present.

We found the listed computers in a central room on the main level of the home as Clark had described. The computers were based on and around a table from which Clark would apparently work. Detective Williams took photos of the computers and electronic equipment. *See Detective Williams' report regarding the computers and their configuration.*

Resting on top of the table holding the computers was a vast amount of paperwork, some in stacks and much of it in disarray. Much of the paperwork was legal discovery material which included police reports and copies of the involved electronic facsimiles. There was also a significant amount of paperwork containing the presumed writings of Andrew Clark, some of which were copies of documents he had provided to me or dropped off at the District Attorney's office outlining the conspiracy against him.

Located amongst the piles of paper was a printout from the Koin Center internet website. (The Portland office of Ogletree Deakins and attorney Leah Lively is located within the Koin Center.) The particular webpage listed the physical features of the building along with the address. The timestamp on the printout was 10/28/13. *See attached copy of Koin Center webpage.*

Also located amongst the piles of paper was the first page of a typed letter to attorney Steven Seymour, presumably written by Andrew Clark based upon the content of the


letter and it's similarity to the writings of Andrew Clark. I noted that the words "Urgent for Stephen Kantor" were handwritten on the letter. The words were written in pencil and were consistent with previous writings and notations of Andrew Clark on electronic facsimiles he had sent out. *See attached copy of letter to attorney Steven Seymour.*

During my examination of the vast amount of paperwork on the table, I came across a letter or memorandum with a letterhead from the law firm of Beckley and Bons. I looked no further at the document or its contents and set it aside to be disregarded. Also within the paperwork on the desk, I found a typed letter or memo that was consistent with the writings of Andrew Clark. When I noticed the name of attorney Kevin Bons in the body of the document, I sat it aside as well.

I located a large paper grocery sack in the main living room at the front of the residence, adjacent to the computer room. The paper sack contained an assortment of mailings and opened envelopes that appeared to have been sorted and discarded for either shredding or disposal. Located amongst the assorted mailings was an unopened envelope addressed to Andrew Clark from the Portland law firm of Samuels, Yoelin Kantor. The unopened envelope was postmarked as having been sent on July 18, 2013. (This was consistent with a certified letter from attorney Steven Seymour that was to be sent to Andrew Clark after my first contact with Clark on July 18, 2013.) Directly adjacent to the unopened letter, as if placed into the paper sack at the same time, was a US Postal Service delivery notice for certified mail. The notice, dated July 20, 2013, was addressed to Andrew Clark at 3270 Stoney Ridge Road. The notice indicated that the certified mail document was undeliverable on that date due to the absence of anyone to sign for it. *See attached copies of the unopened letter and the USPS delivery notice.*

As I prepared a receipt for the items that were to be seized, I arranged for Detective Roth to take post-search photos of the residence. I left a copy of the receipt (Evidence/Property sheet# 179320) prominently displayed on top of the paperwork on the computer table. We left the location at 11:12 a.m. after locking the door behind us.

I then drove to the Eugene Police Evidence Control Unit, where I lodged the listed items of evidence in the Central Evidence Locker.

Kevin:

I appreciate you bringing the issue of attorney-client privileged information to my attention in relation to Eugene Police Department's execution of the search warrant at Mr. Clark's residence today.

In considering how to deal with that issue, and still advise the police concerning their rights and obligations to search for evidence pursuant to their valid search warrant, I was hoping you could provide some assistance.

I will instruct the detectives not to examine (read) any correspondence that appears to be directly between you and Mr. Clark. That certainly would include e-mails and traditional mail. However, if there are any other documentary items that you believe exist that do not fit that description, please advise of their nature or general identifying characteristics so that we can avoid intruding upon your privileged communications with your client.

If there are any other concerns you may have regarding the execution of the warrant, please let me know and I will pass them on to the detectives. Additionally, I am including the lead detective and the detective conducting the forensic computer examinations (if any) in this e-mail, making it possible for you to respond to all of us at once.

Subject: Information Needed to Defend Stalking Charges

Dear Mr. Seymour:

The methods used by Ogletree Deakins to criminalize me are identical to what they did in Maricopa County, AZ. My lawsuits are similar to the ones put into courts there but, they did not have the simple official evidence that City of Eugene Police provided to me. You and the other defendants should want to mediate, as motioned.

Mr. Seymour: In my opinion, Tony Veach of Eugene Violent Crimes felt his time, talent, and respect was violated by being asked to followup on Vampire videos and business faxes, most of which are not even to Ogletree Deakins. If you look at the evidence and consider most of the faxes appear to have been routed directly to your office...it is pure and simple manufacture of crime by you and your client.

I must at this time start drafting litigation against the government entities that allowed themselves to be corrupted by Ogletree Deakins and yourself. It will be filed under 42 USC 1983. The facts will be similar to 6:13.cv.1546.AA but the allegations will be "false arrest" instead of "kidnapping" for example. It will focus more on negligence and gross negligence.

Your corruption of our Prosecutor's office is epic. It is a masterpiece of systematic name-dropping and other influence peddling including coming down from the big city to visit Prosecutor Hasselman, who handles the most lurid violent crimes such as rape and murder. His office is wide open to litigation pursuant to **Buckley v. Fitzsimmons (91-7849), 509 U.S. 259 (1993)** due to your systematic corruption that caused a drunken city prosecutor to create the "bootprint" for Tony Veach. Then you took it to Mr. Hasselman who created yet another bootprint of crime. You appear to be an accomplice at this point. In advance of joining you to the lawsuits in process and in order to defend myself in court against your clients allegations, please explain if and why you disagree given what you did here in Lane County.

Please provide information necessary for my defense against stalking charges here in Lane County.

Please explain the nature of your contact with our former City Prosecutor, Mr. Barkovic, noted in your letter to Tony Veach of Eugene Violent Crimes. You are most likely aware Mr. Barkovic was fired for rather shocking reasons related to drunk driving. It appears he may have been an alcoholic and that may have impaired his judgment when he referred matters relating to Vampires to our Violent Crimes Division. Here are particulars:

1. How do you know Mr. Barkovic, how many times did you speak about the fax-threat? Did you visit him? Did you provide him any meals or alcoholic beverages or any other inducements?





I assisted Det. Veach in the service of a search warrant on 11/05/13 at the residence of Andrew Clark, 3270 Stoney Ridge Drive. I photographed the computer items noted in Det. Veach's report dated 11/06/13 and disassembled items as needed and prepared them for seizure.

The office area of the house was equipped with a Comcast cable modem/wifi/router which was connected via Ethernet cable to the HP 300-1120 personal computer. There were two Aspire One mini-laptop computers on the same table as the HP computer, both of which were capable of wifi reception. I noted that the Aspire One laptop listed

as item 2 was connected via USB cable to a copier/fax/printer/scanner device, an HP LaserJet 1536. The fax machine did not appear to have wifi capability and was not connected to a phone line, and was likely in use only as a printer, copier and scanner.


Both the HP and the first Aspire One were powered up and at account password screens. The second Aspire One laptop was not powered on. I pulled the power cable from the back of the HP. I was unable to remove the battery from the first Aspire One, and instead did a normal shutdown from the log-in screen.

The Kingston DataTraveler 8GB USB "thumb" drive was also found on the table as the three computers noted above. The Acer One ZG5 laptop was found in a drawer of a cabinet in a room next to the office area which appeared to be in use for storage and filing. The DT101 G2 8GB USB "thumb" drive was found in the same area. The Dell Dimension B110 personal computer was located in a crawl space storage area at the bottom of the stairs leading to the basement. This was an older model computer which had been partially disassembled with the removal of the screws mounting the power supply to the case. This computer was not in operation at the time it was seized.

Det. Veach packaged and lodged all items at the EPD Evidence Control Unit. I checked them out on 11/12/13 to conduct forensic examinations of the devices for any evidence in this case. Those examinations will be included in a separate report.
